

Larry R. White Named IMA President-Elect

LARRY R. WHITE, CMA, CFM, CPA, CGFM, has been named IMA President-elect, which means he will become IMA President in 2004-05. Kim R. Wallin, CMA, CFM, CPA, is IMA President for 2003-04. The IMA Board of Directors announced Larry's nomination on February 22, 2003, and members had 30 days after that to nominate other candidates. As no one else was nominated, a unanimous ballot was then cast, and Larry will become the new President-elect July 1, 2003.



A Captain in the U.S. Coast Guard, Larry is currently chief of the Office of Financial Systems at USCG Headquarters in Washington, D.C. He is responsible for the service's financial system architecture, maintenance, and development; CFO Act statement preparation and audit compliance; agency-level managerial costing; and program management of the service-wide Finance Center.

He also has been chief of the Budget Execution Division at USCG Headquarters where he managed seven appropriations with more than \$5 billion in annual funds and prepared the Coast Guard's senior executives for congressional hearings. He has been comptroller at three major Coast Guard facilities: the Training Center in Yorktown, Va., the Integrated Support Center in Portsmouth, Va., and the Coast Guard Finance Center in Chesapeake, Va. Prior to entering the financial management field, he

commanded a patrol boat in Norfolk, Va., and an operations command center in New York City.

A member of the Executive Committee of IMA's Board of Directors, Larry is chair of the Committee on Finance and chair of the Program Committee for the 2003 IMA Annual Conference in Nashville. He joined IMA in 1988, and he served as president of the Hampton Roads Chapter in 1994-95. As President-elect, he will chair the Strategic Planning Committee.

Larry has also been a valuable member of other organizations. He has served as one of three federal CPAs on the AICPA's National Members in Government Committee and is currently a member of the AICPA's Special Committee on Business Reporting. He leads the Coast Guard's participation in the Cost Management Section of the Consortium for Advanced Manufacturing-International (CAM-I).

He holds a bachelor's degree from the U.S. Coast Guard Academy and an MBA degree from Columbia University. ■
