The IMA Board of Directors announced Carl's nomination on February 21, 2004, and members had 30 days after that to nominate other candidates. Carl joined the University of Hartford full-time in 1981 as a lecturer in accounting and has also been an assistant professor of accounting and chair of the Department of Accounting and Taxation. Before that he was manager of data processing and consulting services at Cohen, Rosenfeld, & Lieberman CPAs; a corporate internal auditor at Emhart Corporation; and a lecturer in accounting at Western New England College and the Uni-

He joined IMA in 1976 and was president of the Hartford Chapter in 1983-84. As Chair-Elect, he will head IMA's Strategic Planning Committee.

Carl is also a member of the American Accounting Association, the AICPA, and the Connecticut Society of CPAs. He holds a B.S. degree in accounting, an MBA degree in accounting and management information systems, and a Ph.D. degree from the University of Connecticut. ■
